

# Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees is the decision-making body responsible for defining E2S UPPA's overall strategy, proposing an implementation roadmap, allocating personnel and resources, and monitoring the results of E2S UPPA actions. The trustees represent the consortium, its economic partners and the New Aquitaine Regional Council. As such, they guarantee the coherence of the project in relationship with the socio-economic partners and the local communities.

## COMPOSITION

The Executive Committee comprises eight members appointed for four years:

- \* Three representatives of the consortium: the president of UPPA and the representatives appointed by INRAE and INRIA
- \* Two representatives appointed by the Business Committee
- \* A representative of the French National Center for Scientific Research (CNRS)
- \* A representative of the Regional Council New Aquitaine
- \* The Executive Director of E2S UPPA
