

Students Challenge: Great Final: Monday, June 22nd, 2020

One night to conceive tomorrow's campus



On Monday, June 22nd, at 11 am, watch the **live final** and **award ceremony** of our Students Challenge.

Since November 18th, 2019, the **3 pre-selected teams** have been working on the implementation of their project. On June 22nd, they had 10 minutes to defend their results through a short pitch in front of the jury, and 10 minutes to exchange with its members.

Results of the challenge will be known on the D-day.

Prizes will be awarded by the jury members:

Each member of the victorious team will be awarded a sum of 800. Those of the second and third team will each have 400 and 200 euros, respectively.

Their projects will also be presented on the stands of the Science Villages, on all UPPA sites, in October 2020, with the support of the Lacq Odyssée association. Some will be implemented within the campus, as part of the sustainable development mission and others will be the subject of a communication and dissemination to the public.

Participants were initially distributed in nine teams. Among these nine teams, four had their projects preselected by the jury after this sleepless night. **Three** of them are now, since November 18th, 2019, in the **realization phase**.

They have been granted both human and financial support, and had until June 22nd, 2020, to give life to their ideas.
